The Stillwater Lumberjack Days Downhill Derby provides an opportunity to come together as a community and commemorate the Lumberjack era heritage – and to watch grown adults make fantastically fun vehicles and go down a hill in a tiny car. The Downhill Derby is open to residents and organizations who complete the application process, pay the fee, and are approved by the Stillwater Lumberjack Days Board of Directors.

1st 2nd and 3^d place will be determined by races conducted in a double elimination format

DOWNHILL DERBY RULES

REGISTRATION

- All racers must register in advance. Registration form and fee must be received by the Derby Committee by Friday, July 12, 2019.

Vehicle Specifications

- Vehicle must be no more than 6 feet long, 3 feet high and 3 feet wide.
- An optional roll bar/cage may be added to the top of the vehicle and may exceed the 3 foot height restriction. It must be for driver protection only, must not be decorated and must be approved by race officials.
- Driver must be able to fit into vehicle and operate steering and brakes.
- Driver's head cannot be in front of their feet. No lying down positions will be allowed.
- Please use sturdy materials to build your vehicle. No loose or removable parts will be allowed.
- No pre-manufactured vehicles or vehicles built from kits will be allowed.

Safety Specifications

- Safety checks will begin two hours prior to the official race time.
- Every vehicle must pass a safety inspection and safely complete a test run of the official course.
- Vehicles that cannot maintain steering control or that cannot stop within the specified stopping area will not be allowed to race.
- All drivers will be required to wear a helmet at all times when they are on the race course.
- Race officials will have the right to exclude any vehicle that is deemed not to be safe.
- Please thoroughly test your vehicle before race day to make sure it will pass safety requirements.

- Race format will be a double elimination bracket.
- Vehicles must start and be propelled only by gravity. No pushing or starting assists will be allowed.
- Heats will be started with the front of the vehicle behind the starting line.
- The winner of each heat will be the first vehicle that breaks the plane of the finish line.
- Starts and finishes will be monitored by race officials and their decisions will be final.

Requirements

- Drivers must be at least 18 years of age. Only one person can be in the car when it is racing.
- All entrants are encouraged to be present at a publicity event on Thursday evening, July 18, 2019.
- All entrants must be present 2 hours prior to race time for safety inspection and race instructions.
- Number of entrants will be limited to 20. All entries will be accepted on a first come basis.
- Winner of the event will be required to participate in the parade on Sunday. All other racers are welcome to participate in the parade.

Stillwater Lumberjack Days Waiver Agreement For Release of Claims Downhill Derby
